

Connection PARIS DU NORD – PARIS ST LAZARE

Travel time: 60 minutes

Costs: € 2.10 one-way

Paris du Nord – Paris Saint Lazare (outward journey)

- To travel to Paris Saint Lazare you will need to take a RER city trains. Metro tickets (which are also valid on the RER) can be purchased in the Eurostar buffetcars. Price per person, one-way: € 2.10. We advise you to purchase your metro ticket on board Eurostar, as the ticket desks at Paris North Station can be really busy and there is no price difference.
- Walk to the end of the platform to the main hall when you arrive at Paris Gare du Nord.
- Follow the RER signs and take the stairs down.
- Continue to follow the RER signs when you get to the bottom of the stairs. When the signs start indicating line names, follow the RER (E) line (pink line).
- Go through the gates (hang on to your metro ticket) and follow the signs RER (E) (D4) in the direction of Hausmann - St Lazare.
- Take the train to the first stop (travel time approx. 4 minutes): 'Hausmann St Lazare'. This is also the final destination of this RER train.
- Use your metro ticket to open the gates.
- Follow the signs: 'Sortie, Gare SNCF/Grandes Lignes'.
- The platform number from which your connecting train will depart will be announced 20 minutes before departure on the message boards in the main hall.
- As the trains are long, please keep in mind that it may take you five to ten minutes to walk the length of the platform to your carriage.
- Keep your train ticket ready for inspection just before boarding the train.

Paris Saint Lazare – Paris du Nord (return trip)

- Walk to the end of the platform to the main hall when you arrive at Paris St Lazare station.
- Follow the signs RER (M).
- When the signs start indicating line names, follow the RER (E) line (pink line).
- Go through the gates (hang on to your metro ticket) and follow the signs RER (E2) (E4) in the direction of Chelles Gournay-Tournan.
- Hanging above the platform you will find TV screens which indicate the final destination of the train which is about to arrive. You will also see big signs which indicate all the intermediate stops. On this sign a yellow light lights up to the left of all the station names where the arriving train will stop.
- Take the train to the first stop (travel time approx. 4 minutes): 'Magenta'. All trains leaving from this platform will stop at 'Magenta'. This station lies beside Paris North Station.
- Use your metro ticket to open the gates.
- Follow the signs 'Grandes Lignes' and Eurostar until you get to the main hall.
- Eurostar trains usually depart from platforms 7, 8 or 9. The specific platform will be announced 20 minutes before departure on the message board in the main hall and on the TV screens on the platforms.
- As the Eurostar trains are long, please keep in mind that it may take you five to ten minutes to walk the length of the platform to your carriage.
- Keep your Eurostar train ticket ready for inspection just before boarding the train.

More information about Paris Gare Saint Lazare

Paris Gare Saint Lazare is the departure and arrival station for day trains travelling to and from Normandy (including Le Havre, Cherbourg, Caen, Rouen)

Minimum time needed to transfer from Paris North to Paris Saint Lazare = 1 hour!
